

Set-up Checklist for Cadillac Websites™

1. First, set up a folder on your computer to dump all the text (or doc) files and images. In the text file, make a note of the pages you want to set up. Then write what you want to say on each page, making a note of the name of each image you want included with the text and the location of the image.
2. Do the same for albums - noting the order you want the images displayed.
3. Decide if you want an image, your logo, text or a combination in your masthead, or header. If you have custom artwork, we will need a copy of that also.
4. Think about the colors you want on your site. We have included a useful and versatile color wheel in the administrative backend of your website.
5. If you have a domain name, point the DNS setting to:
NS1.COUGARGULCH.COM and NS2.COUGARGULCH.COM . Even if you have a domain name, you may wish to consider leasing one or more of our domain names to add more traffic avenues to your site. Most our domain names are Search Engine friendly and are seasoned on the web.
6. If you do not have a domain name, we have many available for lease at <http://LeaseMySites.com/> . Most our domain names are Search Engine friendly and are seasoned on the web. Many have page rank of 1 or 2 or more. This is good for your business.
